

## Student grants are available for the 40<sup>th</sup> WWRF Meeting in Durban, South Africa.

Following are the guidelines:

- The students should send their request to the WG Chair of the Forum directly once their paper is accepted
- WG Chair forwards the request to Treasurer with recommendation
- Maximum grant:
  - 1000 Euros for Europe
  - 800 Euros for Middle East & North Africa
  - 1000 Euros for Asia
  - 1000 Euros for North America – Canada, USA, Mexico
  - 1200 Euros for South and Central America
  - 1000 Euros for Australia & New Zealand
  - 800 Euros for Sub- Sarah Africa
- Depending on the cost of travel at the lowest economy class airfares
- Receipts must be provided
- Students must provide proof that they have presented the paper, WG Chair can do that
- Must provide bank details so that our accountant can do electronic transfer
- WWRF pays the registration fee unless the student is using one free academic registration of the Forum member
- It will take 30 days at least to process the claim after it is received
- Please note funds are limited and the awards will be made on a first come first serve basis.
